FIRST MEETING HAPPENS!!!!!!

The first week of October marked the first official meeting of the PSPS. This meeting gave an overview of the direction and philosophy behind what Marlane and I would like to see evolve over time for our paranormal society.

At our next meeting on Sunday, November 8, at 7:00 p.m., we will begin training on the equipment. We will examine the use of the EMFTemperature and K-II Meters.

We have a new EMF/Temperature meter from Professional Measure-

ment. This meter measures electromagnetic fields and temperatures at the same time. The theory is, as the spirit world tries to communicate, the EMF measurements will spike on the digital scale and the temperature could simultaneously drop as the entity pulls energy from the atmosphere. Simultaneous readings could be considered proof of paranormal activity.

The K-II is still experimental. It also measures EMF. Instead of a digital scale it uses a series of diode lights indicating

strength.

We use this piece of equipment in conjunction with a digital recorder and conduct a EVP session using interview protocol based on yes or no answers. Light it up once for yes, twice for no. Sounds too good to be true; maybe, but we have had a couple of remarkable experiences

own actions it is not socially responsible to have the already taxed health system and American taxpayer that are not a part or PSPS pay for stitches or a broken leg. This exclusion is only in the field and doesn't effect individuals from evidence review and other functions.

Ghost or spirit – what's the difference?
